2013 Vintage

92 Points – 2013 Eileen Vineyard Pinot Noir

"Bright red. Tightly wound red berry and Asian spice aromas pick up a suave floral nuance with air. Silky and precise, offering energetic raspberry and bitter cherry flavors with a touch of star anise. A suave, seamless Pinot with no excess weight. Closes tangy and very long, with silky tannins and lingering spiciness. Drinking window: 2018-2023."

2012 Vintage

92 Points - 2012 Eileen Vineyard Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills

"The 2012 Pinot Noir Eileen is the youngest estate-vineyard cuvee that debuted in 2000, so the vines are now around 15 years old, located at the highest elevation (it was once a Christmas tree farm.) It is planted with Dijon clones at 2,300 vines per acre. The nose is very attractive with refined red cherry, wild strawberry and red plum fruit that gently unfolds in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with a pert entry, crisp acidity and lip-smacking salinity. This is nicely structured with firm backbone that neatly offsets that black fruit toward the grippy finish. Give this a year in bottle and then it should continue drinking nicely over the next decade."

"Firm in texture, with a sleek feel to the spicy plum flavors as they glide into a long and expressive finish, trailing hints of toast and iron as they linger. Best from 2016 through 2020."

94 Points – 2010 Eileen Vineyard Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills

"Vivid ruby-red. An exotic perfume of red fruit preserves, blood orange and candied flowers, along with an Asian spice nuance that strengthens with air. Shows very good clarity and intensity on the palate, offering gently sweet black raspberry and rose pastille flavors and a zesty kick of cinnamon. Spicy and precise on the strikingly persistent finish, which features silky tannins and lingering floral notes."

2009 Vintage

92 Points — 2009 Eileen Vineyard Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills

"This begins as a hard, tight wine with hints of rose petal around a core of blackberry hard candy. The balance is superb, and the wine is lively with nuanced, dark notes blending smoke, espresso and bitter chocolate. An intriguing animal scent surfaces after some hours of breathing.
