## 2013 Vintage

92 Points – 2013 Jessie Vineyard Pinot Noir

*"Ruby-red. Highly perfumed scents of dark berries, cola and rose oil.*

*Fleshy, expansive black raspberry and bitter cherry flavors display a suave blend of richness and energy, picking up a spicy character with air.*

*Finishes juicy and very long, with lingering dark fruit flavors and slow-building tannins. Drinking window: 2019-2024."*

## 2012 Vintage

93 Points - 2012 Jessie Vineyard Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills

*"From the steepest east-facing vineyard with heterogenous soil types located just outside the winery, the 2012 Pinot Noir Jessie Vineyard includes about 40 or 50% whole cluster fruit. It has a perfumed, quite floral bouquet with generous crushed strawberry and raspberry scents. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, a lovely mineral-core of fruit cloaked in dark cherry and bilberry fruit. There is fine salinity here, very good depth, with a long and quite powerful saline finish. Excellent."*

*"Jessie is perhaps the gutsiest of the Cristom wines in 2012, a study in dark pinot arts, plum and black cherry fruit notes lent dark spice b whole-cluster fermentation, which may also contribute to an amaro-like note on the finish. The fruit and spice haven't quite converged, but they become more aligned with air, suggesting the wine will benefit from some cellar time."*
