94 Points – 2013 Louise Vineyard Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills

"Deep red. Hugely aromatic bouquet evokes ripe red fruits, incense and Asian spices, along with a bright mineral overtone. Juicy and precise on the palate, offering sweet raspberry preserve, rose pastille and spicecake flavors that deepen and spread out with air. Delivers a suave blend of power and elegance, finishing with harmonious tannins and remarkable clarity and length. Drinking window: 2019-2025."

2012 Vintage

94 Points - 2012 Louise Vineyard Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills

"The 2012 Pinot Noir Louise Vineyard, which is often the first and last fruit to be harvested because part of the vines lack sunshine late in the afternoon. It has a well-defined and very natural bouquet with ebullient red berry fruit intermixed with rose petals and cedar. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, wonderful focus and superb tension right to the finish. This feels a little more compact and backward than Cristom's other 2012, but there is clearly breeding and sophistication here."

"Louise is often the darkest, most concentrated single-vineyard pinot noir in the Cristom portfolio, and in a warm vintage that impression seems all the more intense. A fine, wispy note of smoke adorns the dark plum flavors, with the spicy notes of whole cluster fermentation informing the texture of this wine. The tightness of its weave gives way to a sleek, seamless elegance, providing movement and length."

"Vivid ruby-red. Exotically perfumed scents of cherry-cola, vanillin oak, Asian spices and potpourri. Deeply pitched red and dark berry flavors are complemented by notes of candied flowers, five-spice powder and roasty saffron. Youthfully firm tannins add focus and grip to an impressively long, energetic finish of excellent clarity and lingering spiciness."
